Parent Handbook Reminders

Shoes

For the safety of your child we do not allow open toe shoes, they are so cute we understand, but they are a safety risk.

Sunscreen/bug spray authorization

If you have not already completed a form please get one from the aqua blue stand in the foyer, complete and return to the office. Parents are responsible for providing the sunscreen/bug spray for your child and we will apply.

Withdrawing or adding children

If you plan on withdrawing your child we require four week's notice. Kids Kondo does not provide Pre-K so if you know that your child will attend another school in the fall we appreciate as much notice as possible.

Expectant Moms

As most of you are aware, siblings get priority at Kids Kondo. So if you are pregnant, have a child currently enrolled and wish to enroll

your newborn, please complete an Enrollment Application Form from our web site and pay the registration fee of \$125. There is a shortage of infant spots in the city right now and our infant program is in high demand, so the sooner you complete the enrollment info the better your chances are of getting your desired enrollment date.

Sign in & out sheets

Please keep up the great job of signing in and out each day. Georgia licensing requires parents/guardians to sign-in and sign-out for their children daily in any childcare facility. PLEASE be sure you or anyone else who may be picking up your child is signing in AND signing out each day. The TIME and your SIGNATURE are required.

Child Release Information

Georgia licensing is also requiring childcare facilities to obtain additional information on any person authorized to pick-up your child. To ensure that we have the required information in your child's file, we request that parents complete and sign a new Release Form. They are located in the foyer or you may print a Release Form from our web site [Kids Kondo » Forms](#).

Rate Increase

Beginning the week of May 10th, tuition will increase \$7 per week, per child. Please refer to the Tuition and Fee Schedule for rates.
